Purpose of Study: The purpose of this research is to get a better understanding of the epidemiology of the inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) in the older population (≥ 60 years) and its impact on patients' quality of life (QoL), from both a physical and mental point of view.

Depending upon the depth of your responses, participation time varies from 10 minutes to 15 minutes.

Risks of Being in the Study: No risks are associated with the participation in this study.

Potential benefits: Research participants will be contributing to the development of knowledge about this disease amongst the older population.

Anonymity: Your participation in this research is completely anonymous.

No information you share can be traced electronically to you, the computer you used, nor can you be traced by any information you provide. Data will be kept stored in the on-line survey site's databank.

Voluntary Nature of the Study: Your participation is voluntary, and you may refuse to participate or withdraw at any time.
