## EFCCA ACADEMY TRAINING PROGRAM ON RNA-BASED THERAPIES IN CD

This autumn, we are launching a special training programme on advanced therapies. The first module will focus on RNA-based therapies, in line with the GENEGUT project's goal of developing the first oral RNA-based therapy for Crohn's Disease. Participants will learn about the mechanisms and benefits of RNA-based therapies through pre-recorded modules followed by a knowledge test. Participation is open to all, and our training sessions are free.

## CALL FOR UC PATIENT PARTICIPATION IN INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP

## WORKSHOP ON HEALTH ENGAGEMENT AND NUTRITION-RELATED BEHAVIOURS IN IBD

In December, EFCCA and Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore will host online workshops for the miGut-Health project. These will focus on nutrition and stress in IBD, bringing together EFCCA members, caregivers, physicians, nutritionists, and psychologists. The aim is to explore how stress affects food consumption and how dietary behaviours impact disease activity and patient outcomes.
